## About the role: Head of Procurement

The Head of Procurement's role will comprise managing the selection and implementation of the contracts and purchasing activities for main equipment suppliers and contractors for Harmony Energy's shovel-ready projects. The role is central in ensuring that the projects are delivered on time, to budget, with reliable and quality equipment, before being handed the Harmony Energy's asset management team.

The ideal candidate would be an engineer with development, procurement and construction experience, who is able to perform due diligence on projects and prepare both commercial and technical aspects of tender packages (e.g. drafting project specific Employer's Requirements). The candidate would also have experience leading projects in the run-up to procurement, supporting financing processes, and have experience of negotiating contracts with equipment suppliers and balance of plant contractors.

## Key responsibilities

- Due diligence of projects received from the development team, to ensure buildability.

- Developing group procurement strategies in-line with the growth of the business, including international purchasing optimisations, solar and hybrid projects, new business cases, etc.

## Essential skills and experience

- Degree educated with significant relevant experience. Ideally an Engineering or Electrical Engineering degree.
- At least 7 years' experience in a similar role for a renewable energy developer, contractor or consultancy.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Battery energy storage experience would be a positive but not essential.
